**Booking Payments:**

An initial non-refundable deposit of \$1500.00 per person is payable when booking. Once the tour is full and all components of the tour are confirmed, final balance will be required 23 July.

Payments can be made by any means, however please note that any payments made by credit card will incur an additional 2.5% transaction fee. Costs are subject to change until paid in full. Itinerary changes may be made due to circumstances beyond our control.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### Conditions/Cancellation Penalties

Please note non-refundable deposit of \$1500 per person due when passengers submit their individual booking forms. **Final payment is due no later than 23 July.** Airfare is subject to availability and non-refundable after issue. Once travel has been deposited any amendments, upgrades and name changes may incur fees from suppliers. Payment of a change fee (per passenger) applies plus any applicable upgrade fees to cover the difference between the original fare and the new fare. Accommodation cancellation penalties apply within 90 days prior to travel. Within 60 days of travel, up to 100% cancellation fees may apply. We strongly recommend travel insurance to protect you in some instances for unforeseen cancellation.

### COVID Travel between New Zealand and Norfolk Island

**Australia Entry Requirements** To be eligible to travel to Australia on a quarantine-free flight, customers must:

- Meet standard immigration requirements for Australia <https://covid19.homeaffairs.gov.au/travel-restrictions>
- Have been in New Zealand or Australia for 14 days prior to travel
- Complete an electronic <https://covid19.homeaffairs.gov.au/australia-travel-declaration> online at least 72 hours prior to departure. Please be aware that the responsibility to complete the declaration will be your own.
- Meet any other State Government Health requirements including Norfolk Island's.

### Norfolk Island Entry Pass

You are also required to complete an online **Norfolk Island Entry Pass** 72 to 24 hours prior to your travel date. Please be aware that the responsibility to complete this will be your own. Your flight will be accessible to obtain a Pass not prior to 72 hours prior to your flight at <https://norfolkau.viewpointcloud.com/categories/1083> The Entry Pass can only be obtained online so if you don't have access to a computer, please arrange to use a friend or family members computer in the period 72-24 hours prior to your flight. We have included current information on the Entry Pass and Norfolk Island's COVID-19 preparedness for receiving visitors on our website that you can access at [www.norfolkislandtravelcentre.com/news/travel-to-norfolk-island-in-a-covid-19-environment](http://www.norfolkislandtravelcentre.com/news/travel-to-norfolk-island-in-a-covid-19-environment) I recommend checking in here on a regular basis as we will continually update as any changes occur. **New Zealand Entry Requirements** To be eligible to travel back into New Zealand on a quarantine-free flight, customers must:

- Have been in New Zealand or Australia for 14 days prior to travel.
- During the 14-day period before travel, not had a positive COVID-19 test (or if they have, they must have written advice from a health practitioner that they are no longer infectious).
- Not be awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test that was undergone during the 14-day period.
- Complete a Travel Declaration form prior departure <https://naumaira.covid19.govt.nz/#/>
- Customers will not be able to travel if they have cold or flu symptoms as follows:
  - New or worsening cough
  - Fever (at least 38 degrees Celsius)
  - Sore throat
  - Shortness of breath
  - Runny nose
  - Loss of sense or smell
- Customers with pre-existing conditions which display like cold or flu symptoms (e.g. hay fever) must provide medical evidence in a form of medical certificate or letter from doctor confirming the existing condition at check-in to avoid being denied boarding.
- Customers are not required to present a negative COVID-19 pre-departure test when travelling quarantine-free to New Zealand.

Please note, the New Zealand Government has signaled that if there are community cases of COVID-19 in Australia and flights are paused, it may require people travelling to or returning to New Zealand to get tested for COVID-19 before travelling.
